We would like to inform you that the second round of Bebras Challenge will take place as follows:

- 15<sup>th</sup> Bebras Challenge for Secondary School Students Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025
  - 5<sup>th</sup> BEBRAS Challenge for Primary Students Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup> March 2025

With the exception of Nicosia, the competition for both primary and secondary school students in the other cities will start at the same time. Participants will have to be present on **Saturday, March 8<sup>th</sup> 2025** date at the school venue of their province at the hours indicated below.
